REORGANIZATION OF CERTAIN SIGNAL UNITS

1. Effective 14 June 1946, and pursuant to authority contained in letter, War Department, AG 322 (27 May 46) AO-I-SPMOU-M, dated 4 June 1946, subject: Reorganization of Certain Signal Units, the following units are reorganized as indicated in Inclosure #1:

3104th Signal Service Battalion
169th Signal Heavy Construction Company
3163rd Signal Service Company
226th Signal Service Company

2. Grades and strengths are authorized the units in accordance with the appropriate Tables of Organization and Equipment indicated in Inclosure #1.

3. a. Surplus personnel resulting from these actions will be reassigned by this headquarters.

b. No personnel will be reduced in grade as a result of these actions. Excess in grades will be absorbed through normal attrition and the application of AR 615-5, 7 December 1945.

4. a. Tables of Organization and Equipment indicated in the Inclosure apply for organizational equipment.

b. Equipment required will be furnished in accordance with the provisions of letter, Headquarters, Army Service Forces, SPX 400 (20 Dec 45) OE-I-SPDDP-M, 26 December 1945, subject: "Zone of Interior Supply Procedures - Period II", as amended.

c. Priority A-3 applies for equipment; reference letter, War Department, AG 400 (19 Feb 46) OE-S-G-M, 6 March 1946, subject: "Distribution of Regulated Items of Equipment".

5. Obligation of the appropriate allotment published in Section III Circular No. 178, War Department, 1945, as amended, to the extent necessary is authorized.

6. Pursuant to the authority contained in letter, OCSigO, SPSMT-2, subject: "Change in Assignment of Certain Army Ground and Service Units", dated 7 June 1946, upon reorganization the units are assigned to Fort Monmouth, New Jersey for preparation for extended field service. These are General Reserve Units.


