I. INACTIVATION OF CERTAIN ARMY SERVICE FORCES UNIT. -- Pursuant to authority contained in letter War Department, TAG dated 2 April 1946, file AG 322 (29 Mar 46) AO-I-SPMOU-M, Subject: "Inactivation and Activation of Certain Army Service Forces Unit," the 300th SIGNAL HEAVY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, is inactivated at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey, on 10 April 1946 and concurrently with inactivation is transferred to the control of the War Department.

2. Personnel will be transferred on orders issued by this headquarters.
3. Equipment will be turned in as prescribed in Section VII, RR1-6.
4. Personnel records will be prepared and completed in accordance with current regulations.
5. Unit funds and physical property thereof will be disposed of as prescribed by section IV, RR 1-6.

SECTION I

INACTIVATION OF CERTAIN SIGNAL CORPS GENERAL RESERVE UNITS:

1. Effective 2400 hours, 5 November 1946, and pursuant to authority contained in letter, War Department, Adjutant General's Office, file 322 (16 Oct 46), AO-I-WDGOT-M, dated 23 October 1946, subject: "Inactivation and Reorganization of Certain Signal Corps General Reserve Units", the following units are inactivated at this station:
