

Dr. Ziegler receives AFCEA award

WASHINGTON—The Gold Commendation Medal of the Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association (AFCEA) was awarded to Dr. Hans K. Ziegler of Colts Neck, NJ, Monday (June 10).

Presentation took place at the 28th annual convention of AFCEA in Washington, "in recognition of service performed beyond that which is usually expected, and in appreciation of outstanding leadership, dedication and guidance in a position of responsibility in association affairs, and in recognition of unusual meritorious services rendered to the association."

Dr. Ziegler, Director of the Army Electronics Command Electronic Technology and Devices Laboratory, Fort Monmouth, has been prominent in AFCEA national and local affairs for more than 20 years.

He is now serving in his fourth three-year term as a member of the national board of directors, and is chairman of the nominating committee for national officers this year.

He was president of the Fort Monmouth Chapter in 1960-61, and has received the AFCEA Meritorious Service Award as well as several honor citations.
