

Ballato and Garner elected to fellow grade in IEEE

Two ERADCOM scientists have been elected fellows of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers (IEEE). They are Dr. Arthur D. Ballato of the Electronics Technology and Devices Laboratory and Robert V. Garver of Harry Diamond Laboratories.

Ballato was cited for "contributions to the theory of piezoelectric crystals and frequency control." Garver was cited for "contributions in nonlinear and guided wave optics."

The IEEE said its fellow grade represents "unusual professional distinction, to be conferred upon a person of outstanding and extraordinary qualifications and experience in the fields of electrical engineers, electronics, radio, allied branches of engineering, or the related arts and sciences, who has made important individual contributions to one or more of these fields."

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
