Section I

Redesignation and Reorganization of U. S. Army Signal Research Unit

1. Pursuant to authority contained in letter, SIGCS-3c 320, Office of the Chief Signal Officer, 10 February 1958, subject: "Establishment of Separate Table of Distribution Units," the following unit is redesignated and reorganized at this installation as Class II activity under the jurisdiction of the Chief Signal Officer, effective 15 March 1958:

c. No enlisted man will be reduced in grade as a result of action directed herein. Overstrength in any grade will be absorbed by normal attrition.
