Colonel Nathan M. Swartz Commander Tobyhanna Army Depot

Colonel Nathan M. Swartz becomes the 32nd commander of Tobyhanna Army Depot, the Defense Department's largest facility for the repair, overhaul and integration of Command, Control, Communications, Computer, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance systems. The depot, located in Northeastern Pennsylvania, employs about 3,200 personnel.

Swartz has held leadership positions in the United States and overseas in the 1st Armored Division Friedberg, Germany; 101st Airborne (Air Assault) Fort Campbell, Kentucky; 25th Infantry Division (Light), Schofield Barracks, Hawaii; 1st Infantry Division, Fort Riley, Kansas, and 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Stewart, Georgia. He also served as a logistics assignment officer at Human Resources Command and Colonel Management Office, Senior Leader Development. He has completed multiple deployments to Southwest Asia.

Swartz has a Bachelor of Science in Political Science from Middle Tennessee State University, a Master of Science in Business and Supply Chain Management from the University of Kansas and is a graduate of the Eisenhower School with a Master of Science in National Resource Strategy.

His military decorations and awards include the Bronze Star Medal with four bronze oak leaf clusters and Meritorious Service Medal with one silver oak leaf cluster. He is authorized to wear the Parachutist Badge, Air Assault Badge, Rigger Badge and the Combat Action Badge.
