Tobyhanna Army Depot (TYAD) is the largest, full-service electronics maintenance facility in the Department of Defense (DoD). TYAD is the DoD's recognized leader in the areas of automated test equipment, systems integration and downsizing of electronics systems. Tobyhanna's core competencies are, in part, defined by its dual designations as the U.S. Army Center of Industrial and Technical Excellence (CITE) for C4ISR and Electronics, Avionics, and Missile Guidance and Control, and as the U.S. Air Force Technology Repair Center (TRC) for Command, Control, Communications and Intelligence. Our core competencies rest on nearly 60 years of communications-electronics maintenance and logistics experience. TYAD has trained and developed its work force, built infrastructure and acquired specialized facilities to strengthen and expand its core competencies to support the joint warfighter:

Mission: TYAD's mission is total sustainment, including design, manufacture, repair and overhaul of hundreds of electronic systems that include satellite terminals, radio and radar systems, telephones, electro-optics, night vision and anti-intrusion devices, airborne surveillance equipment, navigational instruments, electronic warfare and guidance and control systems for tactical missiles.

Vision: To be the C4ISR logistics support center of choice for warfighter readiness and transformation.

As an element of CECOM, Tobyhanna also serves Army Team Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C4ISR). Army Team C4ISR is comprised of independent and inter-dependent organizations that are collectively responsible for the life cycle of C4ISR systems. The largest employer in the Pocono Northeast region of Pennsylvania, the installation employs approximately 5,600 personnel from more than 11 counties in the surrounding area. The workforce is primarily made up of engineers, electronics mechanics, computer specialists and industrial trade workers. The Northeastern Pennsylvania Alliance reports that Tobyhanna's presence creates 19,300 jobs and has a regional economic impact of \$4.4 billion. Tobyhanna personnel pay about \$12.7 million annually in state and local taxes.
