Colonel Daryl Gwyneth (Gwen) Devera-Waden recently graduated from the U.S. Army War College, Academic Year 2020, Carlisle Barracks, PA. Prior to that, she was the Mission and Installation Contracting Command (MICC) Chief of Staff at Joint Base San Antonio, Fort Sam Houston (JBSA-FSH), TX.

Born in Philippines but raised in Oxnard, CA since the age of two, COL Devera-Waden entered active duty in June 1996 after graduating from the University of San Francisco, with a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing. She holds a Master of Human Relations degree from University of Oklahoma, a Master of Business Administration degree from Webster University, and a Master of Strategic Studies degree from the U.S. Army War College.

COL Devera-Waden transitioned to the Acquisition Corps in 2006 as Contingency Contracting Officer/Team Leader, 609th Contingency Contracting Team (CCT) at Fort Bragg, NC.
