Colonel Dan Wood is a native of Atlanta, Georgia. He graduated from Columbus State University in 1999 as a Distinguished Military Graduate with a Bachelor of Science and an Active Duty ROTC Commission into the Military Intelligence Corps.

Colonel Wood is a graduate of the Military Intelligence Officer Basic Course, the Signal Captains Career Course, the Combined Arms and Services Staff School, and the College of Naval Command and Staff. Col. Wood also holds Masters Degrees from Columbus State University, Columbia University, and The United States Naval War College. He served as the Army's Fellow for Information Technology and Strategy at Carnegie Mellon University and as a visiting Military Fellow at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies in Washington.

Col. Wood served in numerous company and field grade staff and command assignments from tactical to strategic echelons, including the 75<sup>th</sup> Ranger Regiment; 173<sup>rd</sup> Airborne Brigade; HQ, V Corps; 21<sup>st</sup> Signal Brigade, United States Army Forces Command; 160<sup>th</sup> Signal Brigade, United States Military Academy at West Point; and United States Strategic Command. Col. Wood commanded the 52d Signal Battalion, supporting both United States European Command and United States Africa Command. Following battalion command, he served as a founding member of the Army's Enterprise Cloud Management Agency under the Office of the Army Chief Information Officer, serving as the Army's Chief of Cloud Solutions and the Chief of Cloud Enablement.

His deployments include operations in Bosnia, Kosovo, Iraq and Afghanistan.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (4 OLC), the Air Assault Badge, Basic Aviation Badge, the German Armed Forces Proficiency Badge (Gold); the Expert Infantryman Badge, the Combat Action Badge, and the Ranger Tab. Col. Wood is a recipient of the Signal Corps Regimental Association's Bronze Order of Mercury and the George C. Marshall Leadership Excellence Award.
