

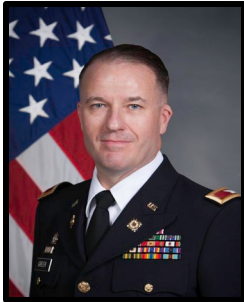

Colonel Joel M. Greer

Director, CTSF, Fort Hood, TX



Colonel Joel M. Greer assumed duties as the 11th Director of the Central Technical Support Facility on September 16, 2021. Colonel Greer was commissioned in 1995 as an Ordnance Officer through the Army Officer Candidate School in Fort Benning, Georgia. He received a Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA) with specialization in Business Management from Saint Leo University and a Master's in Business Administration (MBA) Degree from the Naval Postgraduate School.

His military education includes the Ordnance Officer Basic Course, Combined Logistics Captain's Career Course, the Intermediate Level Education Course, and the United States Army War College. He is Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act (DAWIA) Level III certified in Contracting and Level I in Program Management.

Colonel Greer's first assignment as an Ordnance Officer was as the Maintenance Platoon Leader, 68th Engineer Company, 62nd Engineer Battalion at Fort Hood, Texas. He then served as the Executive Officer in Headquarters, and Headquarters Company 13th Corps Support Command at Fort Hood, Texas. Following the Combined Logistics Captain's Career Course, he served as Commander of Bravo Company, 1st Battalion, 81st Armor Regiment at Fort Knox, Kentucky.

Colonel Greer's first assignment as an Acquisition Corps Officer was as a Contracting Officer supporting the Directorate of Contracting at Fort Hood, Texas where he deployed to Victory Base, Baghdad, Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. There he served as a Contracting Officer and Operations Officer in the Joint Contracting Command—Iraq/Afghanistan. Colonel Greer then participated in the Training with Industry program at Harris Corporation in Palm Bay, Florida. Following the Intermediate Level Education course, Colonel Greer served as the Team Lead of the 631st Contingency Contracting Team at Fort Knox, Kentucky and deployed to Pakistan where he served as the Chief of Contracting for the Office of the Defense Representative – Pakistan in Islamabad, Pakistan. Next he served as the Executive Officer to the Director of the Defense Contract Management Agency at Fort Lee., Virginia. He then went on to serve as Director, Mission and Installation Contracting Command, Fort Bliss and Commander of the 919th Contracting attalion located at Fort Bliss, Texas. Prior to taking command of the 418th CSB, he served as Chief, Force Management Division, III Corps G-3.

Colonel Greer's awards and decorations include the Defense Meritorious Service Medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Meritorious Service Medal with three oak leaf clusters, the Army Commendation Medal with three oak leaf clusters, the Army Achievement Medal with three oak leaf clusters, the Good Conduct Medal, the National Defense Service Medal with service star, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the Iraq Campaign Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the Humanitarian Service Medal, the Noncommissioned Officer Professional Development Ribbon, the Army Service Ribbon, the Army Overseas Service Ribbon with numeral 3, and the Joint Meritorious Unit Award.

Colonel Greer is married to the former Ms. Maxine Galarita of Austin, Texas. They are the proud parents of twin daughters, Allison (17) and Cassandra (17), and son Garrett (13).
