ABOUT AMLC

The Army Medical Logistics Command delivers medical materiel readiness through integrated medical materiel distribution, forward positioned stocks, centralized medical materiel management, and data management to sustain health services for the operational Army units and Joint Forces in support of large-scale combat operations. As the Army's home for medical logistics, AMLC is focused on synchronizing and integrating medical logistics capabilities at echelon in support of the Army's operating force and joint team. Supported at its core by a strong and resilient workforce, AMLC is headquartered at Fort Detrick, Maryland, and oversees a worldwide team of medical logisticians and sustainers.

AMLC's three subordinate commands:

- The U.S. Army Medical Materiel Agency headquartered at Fort Detrick
- The U.S. Army Medical Materiel Center–Europe (USAMMC–E), located at Pirmasens, Germany; Germany Kaiserslautern Army Depot, Germany; and U.S. Army Garrison Rheinland–Pfalz Kleber, Germany
- The U.S. Army Medical Materiel Center–Korea (USAMMC–K), located at Camp Carroll, Korea; and Camp Humphreys, Korea

Serves as the Army's life cycle manager for medical materiel, delivering integrated sustainment and data management to enable health services in support of operational Army units and Joint Forces worldwide.



AMLC REPORTING UNITS



U.S. Army Medical Materiel Agency (USAMMA)

USAMMA provides worldwide operational medical logistics support, maintenance, and centralized management of readiness-enabling contingency programs. Programs include the acquisition, storage, distribution, and transfer of pre-positioned stocks located ashore and afloat as well as medical chemical defense packages and short shelf life pharmaceuticals and other materiel.



U.S. Army Medical Materiel Center Europe (USAMMC-E)

USAMMC-E serves as Theater Lead Agent for Medical Materiel for U.S. European Command and U.S. Africa Command. Provides medical materiel support for U.S. Central Command, serves as the Executive Agent to the U.S. Department of State for its medical humanitarian assistance program, and provides logistics services to U.S. embassies throughout the world. USAMMC-E primarily provides capabilities in the acquisition, storage, and distribution of medical materiel, optical fabrication, and medical equipment maintenance.



U.S. Army Medical Materiel Center Korea (USAMMC-K)

USAMMC-K serves as Theater Lead Agent for Medical Materiel for U.S. Forces in Korea and provides medical materiel support to theater medical forces, ensures tactical units are integrated into the medical supply chain, and assists the Combatant Commander in health logistics support planning. USAMMC-K contributes to Eighth Army's medical readiness by managing and fielding counter-measures used in the protection and treatment of Soldiers in the event of a chemical, biological, radiological, or nuclear attack.
