DISCONTINUANCE OF PIGEON BREEDING AND TRAINING BRANCH
ACADEMIC SERVICES DEPARTMENT, U.S. ARMY SIGNAL SCHOOL

1. Pursuant to authority contained in Memorandum, Serial Number 56-1, Office of the Chief Signal Officer, 25 May 1956, "Organizational Policy of the Chief Signal Officer," and letter, Headquarters, U.S. Army Signal Garrison, Fort Monmouth, N.J., dated 25 April 1957, subject: "Discontinuance of Pigeon Breeding and Training Branch," the Pigeon Breeding and Training Branch, Academic Services Department, U.S. Army Signal School is discontinued, effective 1 May 1957.

2. a. Personnel rendered surplus as a result of this order will be reassigned by this headquarters.

b. Personnel spaces rendered surplus as a result of this order will revert to the control of this headquarters.

c. No enlisted man will be reduced in grade as a result of the action directed herein. Overstrength in any grade will be absorbed by normal attrition.

3. Property of the Pigeon Breeding and Training Branch will be disposed of in accordance with current regulations.

4. Administrative records will be disposed of in accordance with paragraph 27 b (2), AR 345-200; paragraph 14 thru 22 and paragraph 24 b of Standard Procedure Ft Mon (SC) 345-200-2.
