Ms. Danielle Moyer

Deputy Executive Director, Software Engineering Center



Ms. Danielle Moyer was selected as the Deputy Executive Director to the United States Army Communications-Electronics Command (CECOM) Software Engineering Center (SEC) on January 8, 2018.

As the Deputy Executive Director, Ms. Moyer is responsible for providing state of the art software engineering products and services throughout the Army and Department of Defense. SEC supports over 200 systems/programs from Command, Control, Computers, Communications, Cyber, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C5ISR) to logistics, business and enterprise systems all in the modern digital environment. She oversees SEC's directorates, ensuring effective integrated mission accomplishment by a global organization of over 2,500 military, civilian and industry employees, with an annual budget in excess of \$600 million. Ms. Moyer also became dual hatted in 2019 and took the role of Director of the CECOM Office of Acquisition Support that oversees the award and execution of all CECOM contracts.

Her previous assignment was Chief of the Contracting Office (COCO) for the United States Army Contracting Command-Aberdeen Proving Ground (ACC-APG), where she was responsible for thousands of contract actions supporting the research, development, production and sustainment of both hardware and software of C5ISR systems, valued up to \$7 billion. As COCO, Ms. Moyer also supported Program Executive Office (PEO) Aviation and the newly formed Army Rapid Capabilities Office (RCO). Before she was selected as the COCO, Ms. Moyer was an ACC-APG Branch Chief supporting the Program Executive Office for Command Control and Communications-Tactical (PEO C3T). There, she led the transition of the former Joint Tactical Radio System (JTRS) program contracts from the Navy to the Army, and competed each of the Tactical Radio program contracts in record time, which were valued up to \$12 billion. Ms. Moyer also led the requirement, solicitation and phase I awards of the \$37 billion Army Responsive Strategic Sourcing for Services contract. In her contracting role, Ms. Moyer pioneered long-term sustainment considerations in contracts developed at private expense and the no profit/fee on contract incidental initiative.

Former additional assignments include Contracting Officer for the United States Army Contracting Command supporting the Rapid Equipping Force, the Joint Improvised Explosive Device Defeat Organization, and PEO Soldier, and, as a Contract Specialist for the United States Army Corps of Engineers, where she supported 9/11 efforts, and multiple natural disasters, including Hurricane Rita and Katrina.

Danielle Moyer holds a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from the University of Baltimore and a Master's Degree from the Naval Postgraduate School.

Ms. Moyer's awards include the 2015 Army Acquisition Executive Excellence in Leadership Award for Contracting Professional, the 2012 and 2013 Army Contracting Command Annual Awards for Excellence in Acquisition Change Advocate for Major Weapons Systems and the Medal for Meritorious Civilian Service.
